TRUST ME

Sitting on a plane recently heading off to Croatia, I was listening to the calming and reassuring voice of the captain telling us to 'sit back and enjoy the journey'. The captain went on to say, 'If there are any turbulences, delays or time changes that we need to be aware off, don't worry, you will be notified in good time. 'His soothing voice and comforting words brought me peace, which is what I needed especially as he was someone I had never met, never saw and certainly had never seen his flying credentials or certificates, and as we flew into the unknown, I could 'sit back and relax'. What the captain was really saying moments after I boarded the plane and settled into my seat was. Trust Me. And Trust Me are two words that are often used to bring assurance or reassurance, and whether it's through doctors, nurses, driving instructors, pastors, school teachers, emergency services, employers, friends, spouses, parents or taxi drivers they are words that have the ability to instil belief. However, 'Trust Me' can also have the opposite effect especially if they have a fickle track record. Today, in a 'dog-eat-dog' world it's very hard to trust anyone especially with people's inconsistency and selfishness. The definition of 'trust me' is to have a: `firm belief in the reliability, truth or ability of someone` and so when someone says, 'Trust Me' we can have mixed feelings. In Psalm 84:12, David writes 'Blessed are those who trust in God' and personally, that brings me the peace I need in today's unnerving society. But even then, we all struggle at times to trust God especially if we feel He has failed us, not answered our prayers, gone silent or become distant. But in a world where it is difficult to have confidence in anyone or anything, I would still rather put my trust in a God who says, `nothing is impossible with Him' [Matt.19:26] even if I do doubt His existence, get irritated with Him or struggle to understand Him, because at least I have a confidence and a hope in something greater than anything this world can ever offer me. When the world's hope is diminishing more and more by the day, it is still better to Trust God than be reliant on ourselves, even if we do feel God has abandoned us. When Christ died and rose again it was God really saying, you can `Trust Me` because if I can do the miraculous for Jesus, then I can do anything for you. Furthermore, God will ALWAYS do things contrary to the way we would like, but 'Trust Me', being in 'God's hands' is still better than 'taking matters into our own hands.' Blessings. Paster Steve
