#### YOU REAP WHAT YOU SOW

One of the best harvest verses in the bible is found in 1 Corinthians 3v6 which says 'I [apostle Paul] planted the seed, Apollos watered it, but God has been making it grow. And I want to reflect on 3 thoughts from this text now. 1. We Are All Servants. We all have a duty to `plant a seed' which is to share the Gospel with those we come into contact with. God never intended evangelism to be shared by 1 or 2 but by every bible-believing Christian. We have no power in ourselves to convert but we are simply God's mouthpieces and by His Holy Spirit, He uses us to extend His Kingdom. Remember, `when you sow, you will reap`. 2. We All Have Different Gifts and Purposes. Some plant. Some water. Some reap. In other words, God uses us all but in many different and varying ways, yet, we all have gifts to use and a purpose to perform. Some people have up-front ministries while others serve behind the scenes. Some go across the seas to share the gospel while others stay at home. Many speak in front of thousands while others prefer the oneto-one approach. But whatever the method, they are all equally important and vital in us fulfilling God's work in bringing in the harvest of lost souls. Furthermore, whatever talents you have or whatever your approach is, just make sure you are being used for the glory of God. 3. We Are All In It Together. We are not to compete against each other but to complement each other. We all need one another and each other's gifts to carry out God's work. When jealousy, envy or resentment `rear their ugly heads` then God`s work will be thwarted. It`s Christians working together that will bring about revival and see a `harvest of souls'. And remember this: your 'gift' is what you are good at. Moreover, we are tools God uses for a greater harvest and so I want to encourage you this Harvest time, to participate with God and with your church in bringing about a bumper crop! Please pray that God will touch many lives and that we will see His Kingdom extended here in Swindon. Remember, `a fruitful harvest requires a faithful witness`. So maybe today you need to go and PLANT a seed and when it gets WATERED, be amazed by how much God will make it GROW. Blessings. Partor Stew
