UNITED WE STAND, DIVIDED WE FALL

J. K. Rowling author of the Harry Potter books said, 'We are only as strong as we are united, as weak as we are divided'. And Latin writer and mime artist Publilius Syrus said, 'Where there is unity, there is aways victory'. The theme for our church weekend away back in August was unity and for a church, organization, movement or business to thrive and be successful, then the key component has to be unity. And if there is to be longevity with any group or establishment then unity will also play its part. If church programmes are to be productive then unity will be the defining factor in all of them. If committees, trustees, board of directors or church leadership teams are to prosper, then unity will be at the forefront of all their decision-making, strategies and policies. If volunteers, staff, workforces and employees are to feel valued and respected, then unity will also play a big part in keeping them happy, fulfilled and driven. Unity is such a key factor in all walks of life and without it, churches will struggle to make an impact, businesses can `go out of business', organisations can 'grind to a halt' and consequently people can be made redundant. Unity: such a SMALL word but can make such a BIG difference in the success of any institution. Unity is the driving force behind any church or company yet, it is so often missing. When unity is missing, the 'bigger picture' can become distorted and consequently, the work could be damaged, derailed, ruined or thwarted. Unity doesn't always mean everyone will get on, like each other or always agree with the decisions that are made, but what unity does mean, is that 'everyone is pulling together in the same direction` irrespective of their own desires, always wanting the best for that 'specific group', and therefore will put egos and personal agendas to one side for the betterment of those they are working with or for, or the development of the work they are involved in'. During Covid and with all the problems that caused, one thing that got stronger was the unity within our fellowship. In fact. I believe there is a greater united spirit within our church now because of Covid and the effect it had on all of us. Unity `looks beyond personal gain but looks out for what others need`, and if we are to see our church grow numerically and spiritually and to reach out emphatically to a hurting and broken community then unity will be the key component. When a church is united, the opportunities are endless`. One of the most quoted Aesop Fables is probably `United We Stand, Divided We Fall' which literally means, when we are United there will be no division, just harmony, and the greater the harmony, the greater the success, but when there is no unity in the church, the devil will get in and the church will fall and `there WILL be trouble ahead', not 'MAYBE trouble ahead' as Irving Berlin wrote in his song, 'Let's face the music and dance', but 'there WILL be trouble ahead. So, let's continue to be `United in Love` and as Apostle Paul says in 1 Corinthians 1:10, `I appeal to you, brothers and sisters, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree with one another in what you say and that there will be no divisions among you, but that you be perfectly united in mind and thought'.
