#### **CUTTING CORNERS**

In 2010 an explosion aboard the Deepwater Horizon oil rig, killed eleven workers and five million barrels of black crude oil spilled into the Gulf of Mexico. Consequently, the cost of overall court settlements was estimated at \$8 billion. In addition, a fine of \$17.6 billion was handed out to British Petroleum [BP] who were responsible for the tragedy, and a further \$24 billion was lost in oil and natural gas investments, which sadly meant 162,000 people losing their jobs. What was the cause of this disaster? Two words: `Cutting Corners`. Yes, a considerable violation and catastrophe occurred, because the company failed to listen and respond to concerned staff over the oil rig safety procedures. Recently, I was approaching a T junction in my car, when another vehicle that was entering the same road I was exiting 'cut the corner' and drove halfway over my lane. The motorist's erratic driving caused me to swerve to avoid hitting him and I nearly mounted the pavement in the process. Furthermore, and apart from my 'heart missing a beat' and a stare from me to the man responsible, no harm was done. However, the action of a careless motorist could have been far more serious with farreaching consequences. 'Cutting corners' when driving is a dangerous offence and 'cutting corners' in any walk of life can be a 'risky business' too. And although it may 'speed up the process', save money or achieve instant success, in the long run, the consequences of this decision, as I have already shared, can have a negative or extremely devastating effect on us. Moreover, 'cutting corners' can not only lead to heartache and pain, but our conscience can also take a battering too. And cutting corners can also apply to us Spiritually, because in the Christian faith it's very easy to cut corners. For example: we don't pray as much as we should, because of our next pressing appointment. We cut corners in our family life as we don't spend much time with them, rationalizing that they will understand. We cut corners in our church giving [offering] by refusing to give God what He is due. We cut corners in our church attendance or service to God, arguing there are more pressing needs to attend to or we simply 'don't have the time'! Cutting corners is never a good idea whether that's in our business, family, personal or Spiritual life because of the negative effect it can have on us. Jesus never 'cut corners'. He was deliberate, intentional, focused and totally committed to His purpose and His mission. Even leading up to the Crucifixion he could have 'cut a few corners', but he stayed true to his convictions and without compromise, served God wholeheartedly. Whatever issues you are facing currently, whether its mental, physical, or Spiritual, I urge you not to 'cut corners' but do the 'Jesus thing' because your long-term gain is worth it. So, if you are in a 'tight corner' because you took a short cut, maybe you need to 'turn the corner' because 'around the corner' there may be much blessing, because you refused to 'cut corners'.
