#### GOOSEBUMPS

`The life of the Christian is wondrously ruled in this world, by the consideration and meditation of the life of another world'. [Richard Sibbes] All of us experience goosebumps at some point in our lives whether it's from being cold or experiencing strong emotions, especially listening to a song or watching some great sporting event of vesteryear that brought back some wonderful memories. And when I think back to when my children Daniel and Naomi [twins] were born in 1995 and reminisce about seeing two beautiful babies appear `right before my very eyes` and in half an hour of each other, was simply incredible. And goosebumps is what I had recently at a Tuesday Communion service in the hall as our thoughts turned to what Heaven will be like, as we compared the differences of today's world with the beauty of tomorrow's world with Jesus, Imagine a place, although hard to believe at times, where there will be no more sicknesses, death, health problems, hatred, murder, evil, anger, hostility, stealing, blasphemy, selfishness or regret and so on and so on. It can be overwhelming and hard to fathom at just the very thought of eternal life with Jesus. But be encouraged, for there is such a place for Christians when Jesus returns. Furthermore, whenever we ponder on eternity with God and the beauty of Heaven, I am sure we all get goosebumps and I believe when goosebumps come upon us when we are reflecting on Jesus, it is a sign that God's Spirit is at work in our bodies, it is also God reminding us that He is still with us and that we are passionate about the things of God too. You only get `Goosebumps for Jesus' when you allow Him to saturate your life with His power. But the most poignant time when I get goosebumps is when I look to the Cross of Jesus Christ, and the strong emotions I experience about what Christ did for me, never fails to affect my body. I am convinced that Peter would have had goosebumps when Jesus hugged Him after reinstating Him as a disciple and Mary too, especially when the Angel appeared gleaming like lightning and even more so, when she was told about God's plan for her to give birth to Jesus. I am also convinced that Zacchaeus would have had goosebumps when Jesus looked up with His *piercing* eves to see Him in the sycamore tree, as well as the thief next to Jesus on the Cross when Christ turned his head towards him and said, 'today you will be with me in paradise'. [Luke 23: 43] And even the Centurion at the foot of the Cross would have been covered from `head to toe` in goosebumps when he saw Christ's broken body before him as he knew he was looking at the Saviour of the world. So, as the weather gets colder, and boy was it cold last week, don't get goosebumps from the cooler temperature, but because you `turned up the heat` in your relationship with God. Jesus' blessings.
