KEEP YOUR EYES ON THE ORANGE LIGHT

When visiting the eye clinic last Monday, I was asked by the eye technician to position my head in something that looked like the inside of a giant egg. The technician told me 'Don't look to the left or to the right, but keep looking at the orange light in front of you'. In fact, the technician said it several times because when the test started, she knew it would be easy for me to lose concentration and then the computer would give a false reading of the condition of my eyes. The technician kept repeating herself, 'Don't look to the left or to the right, but keep looking at the orange light in front of you', because she knew just how easy it is to get distracted. And although the technician was only reciting a very well-rehearsed script for her clients, for me, they were very profound words, but not for my eyes, but for what every Christian should be doing in the difficult days in which we live: `Don`t look to the left or to the right, but keep looking at the orange light in front of you, and the orange light in this instance, is the bright light of Jesus Christ. In these dark days and trying times, it's easy to get distracted, but I encourage you all not to be swayed by 'looking to the left or to the right', but to stay firm on what you believe and with your eyes firmly rooted on Christ himself. It's very easy to get angry, despondent, upset and disillusioned with world events and world news but keep focused, for Matthew 24:13 says, 'the best is yet to come' for those who follow Christ, and as every believer knows, Jesus wins through eventually. Furthermore, the devil is out to destroy this world and is doing a very good job, we also know that the world is going to get much worse before it gets better, and we also know, it's all part of the end times prophecy. So, I encourage every bible-believing Christian to be diligent, focused and to stay true to their spiritual convictions, because we can easily get distracted if we aren't. With the world having just celebrated Halloween which is commonly known as satan's birthday, we know just how important it is to keep the light of Jesus shining in a very dark world. At the eye clinic last week, the orange light was a very small dot, but every day the orange light of Jesus gets bigger and bigger, brighter and brighter as Christ returns gets nearer and nearer. So, I encourage you all to, 'keep your eyes on the orange light. Jesus Blessings. Paster Steve
